



Introduction

ISU Narvik was established in October 2003. Now it consists of about 200 international students in HiN from 15 different countries. The majority of them are Chinese and Russian.

As usual, international students come for minimum 3 years. First year includes course of Norwegian language and social science. But last two year in increasing frequency students come for just half a year.

Current ISU Narvik Executive Board was elected on 12 April 2005 during General Assembly. It consists of the following positions:

Due to personal reasons ISU Narvik Executive Board didn't look like a complete organization. Actually, there were just four permanent active members in the second term of the study year 2005/2006.

Election of the next Executive Board will happen during next ISU Narvik General Assembly (28.04.06). The procedure of election of ISU Narvik Executive Board is described in *the Constitution of International Students' Union in Narvik* (**Article 4**, part **Election of the Executive Board**).



Activities for the period 10.10.05 – 10.04.06

- Current Executive Board realized its essential goal as creation of financial, organizational and juridical basis of the organization
- Regulated contacts with the administration and some of the organizations at Narvik University College were established
- The Executive Board worked out a plan (see attachment 1) for the year 2006 and a budget (see attachment 2) based on that plan. In November 2005, the Executive Board applied for financial support (in the size of 20000 crones) for year 2006 to the administration of Narvik University College. As a result, ISU Narvik got its own long term period financial support (20000 crones) for the first time
- ISU Narvik lobbied direct funding from Narvik University College administration and succeed it
- For the organisation of Cultural Week (27.03.06 – 31.03.06) ISU Narvik got funding of 6000 crones from Narvik Student Parliament (from the fund ‘‘project recourses for internationalisation’’)
- The Constitution of ISU Narvik was thoroughly revised and a lot of changes were made. During General Assembly The proposal for the new ISU Narvik Constitution was approved
- ISU Narvik took part in discussion of new examination rules at Narvik University College
- The proposal for resolution ‘‘Gebyr for å få behandlet oppholds-, arbeidstillatelse for utenlandske studenter’’ (written by the ISU Narvik Executive Board member – Ivana Gancheva) was approved by the ISU Narvik Executive Board
- ISU Narvik was successfully promoted in Narvik University College and in the town of Narvik in general:
 - ISU Narvik took part in Winter Festival in co-operation with VinterFestUka Stiftelsen
 - During Winter Festival international students appeared on a stage with live program at Narvik University College
 - From 26th to 31st at Narvik University College it was organised Cultural Week, which one included quiz day, table tennis tournament, international party in student



bar, live concert and free for fee Chinese and Russian food. Edel Storelvmo (Rector of Narvik University College) took part in dinner concert with a speech. Randy Melgård (Cultural Chief in Narvik town administration) visited Friday concert also

- ISU Narvik began with radio program on Student Radio
- A series of international evenings are organised at school (movies, presentations and discussions of essential cases)
- Due to high activity both at Narvik University College and in Narvik town ISU Narvik got invitation from Arbeiderparti in Narvik to take part in a concert and a dinner dedicated to celebration of 1st May

Two international students are serving on both ISU Narvik and Narvik Students Parliament (Irina Kudryashova is the treasurer of both organisation and Ivana Gancheva is international responsible in Narvik Students Parliament and Organising Officer in ISU Narvik). It helps to get complete information about current activities and upcoming events.

On ISU Narvik – Narvik Students Parliament meetings some important cases were discussed:

- work agreement between ISU Narvik and SPiN, where sides had a lot of disagreements but reached a consensus
- evaluation of Cultural Week and Winter Festival at Narvik University College
- evaluation of co-operation with Narvik VinterFestUka Stiftelsen
- problem of recruiting of new students
- co-operation with Narvik Student Samfunnet (Fadderordning)
- other
