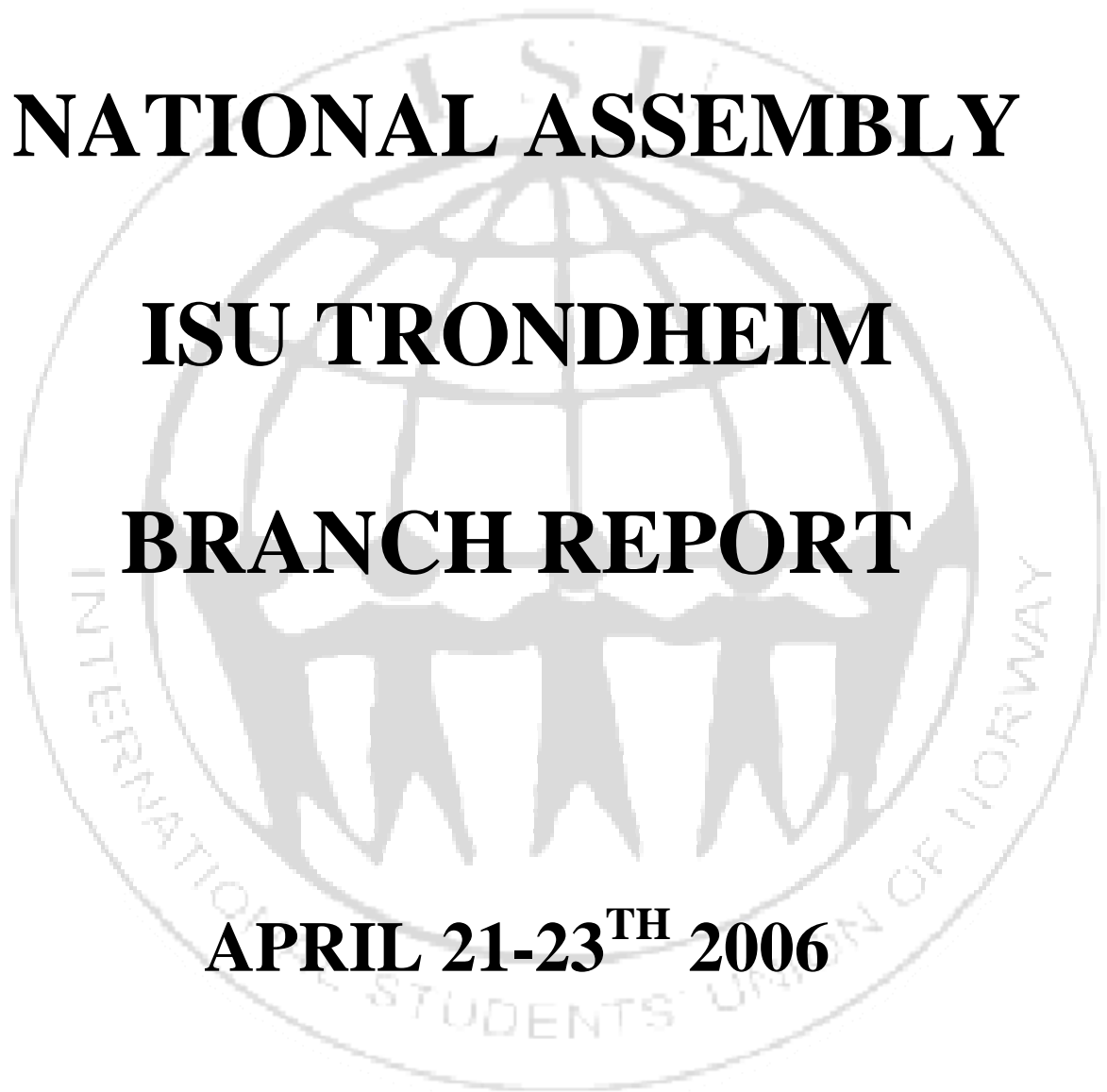

Application for financial Support

In the following you will find the application of ISU for financial support for the year 2006. Every year we would like to offer some activities for the international students in Trondheim, in order to make their stay as pleasant as possible and to give them a taste of Norway. We are going to present you what we plan to organize during the following year.

As we are using one of the basements in Moholt as a meeting point for students, we get some fixed expenses that you will find in the following table.

Object	Cost
Rent of the basement	5000
Internet	2500
TV Fee	4400
Cleaning expenses	1000
Energy	10000
Total	22900

We organize some regular events in this place, such as projecting movies, parties or game nights. Unfortunately, someone burgled the basement during the holidays and stole some of the equipment, among other things the computer and the DVD-player. To avoid that it happens again, we need to install an extra lock. Expenses due to the robbery :

Computer	5000

To entertain the students we would like to offer some activities, like a trip to Ålesund, parties or barbecues. ISU lends some maps to the students who want to go on a cabin trip. To make some trips easier, we plan to buy some GPS.

To sum up, we split our expenses in three categories and the amount of money we need to reach our objectives is 50890 Nok.
