Application for financial support from the International Students' Union Trondheim

The ISU Trondheim hereby applies for financial support for the year 2007.

Every year, we would like to offer some activities for the international students in Trondheim (from NTNU, HiST and other secondary schools) in order to make their stay as pleasant as possible, to promote intercultural exchange and understanding and to give international people a taste of Norway.

Since we, as a principle, are a non-profit organization, would like to entertain the international students and use one of the basements at the student village Moholt as a meeting point for students, we have some fixed expenses as well as others that are variable, both of which are listed below. We estimate we will need the stated sum as support to be financially secure to organize these activities next year.

*If a trip is planned, we will of course collect a participation fee from the students; however, some money is needed beforehand to be able to plan the trip and pay in advance as well as to be financially secure in case unforeseen events make the trip impossible, but the costs remain. In addition to this, we support activities such as Eurodinner and dinner at the Studenterhytta for international students as well as the Buddy Program, which is financially dependent on this support and with which no financial profit is made.

As representatives of all the international students in Trondheim, we would like to thank International House for making our stay so pleasant and for supporting our activities! Without this support we would surely not be able to organize and offer so many things to the international students.
