My name is Ramil Aliyev, 29, Azerbaijan. I study Human Rights Law at the Norwegian Center of Human Rights at the University of Oslo. I have been involved in working for the student rights and democracy since 2003 (I have a Vice President of ISU Tromsø and ISU Oslo). I was elected as a Vice President of ISU Norway in 2006 (I lost to Eton by flipping a coin).

Duties and Responsibilities of National Vice – President

“§ 3.2 National Administration

...

In cases where the President is not available for important events or periods, the Vice - President shall serve as his/her representative and shall be granted the authorities of President on an interim basis. In cases where the Vice - President is not available for important events or periods, the Alternate Vice - President acts on his/her behalf. The Alternate - Vice - President is a generally passive position.”

My main work since September as a National Vice President was:

- Individual meetings and discussion with the UiO professors, international students, NGOs and politicians.
- Visa Fee Case: Lobbying, bringing topic to discussion, comparing and getting support.
- Solving problems of International Students and consulting
- Raising awareness about the ISU (among the international Students and others)

- Organizing a joint project with ISU Oslo – Azerbaijan: 15 Years Later
- Academic Review of Norway
