C) General Assemblies

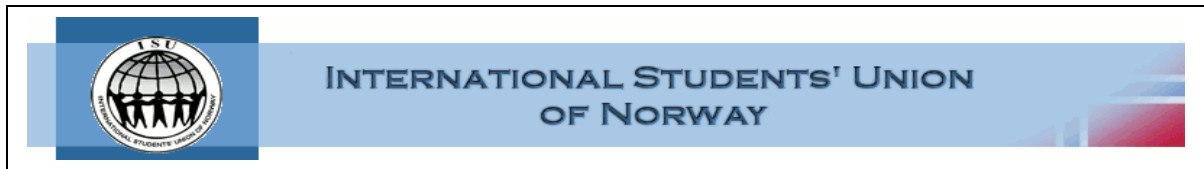
A General Assembly was held on Feb 6th2008. StOr International officer was present.
