ISU – Stavanger Branch Activities

Overview

The International Students' Union (ISU) of Stavanger University College (SUC) was established on the 10th of February 2004, and have established her presence in the university community, to the extent that the body has been given an office by the university authorities to co-ordinate her activities.

To foster the continuity ISU in SUC, new executives officers were elected upon the convocation of a General Assembly held on August 21, 2004. Currently ISU can boast of about 150 memberships in SUC chapter.

Journey so far

Upon assumption of office, the following activities and milestones have been achieved by the new executives:

- Proper handover of roles, responsibilities and document files from the ex-board members on September 11, 2004. This date signal our official commencement of responsibilities to the union.
- Till date, the new executives have had two board meetings in which we deliberated on the issues to keep ISU in focus. The meeting is intended to be held weekly, this shall afford us the opportunity to Plan, Do, Check and Review activities and developments in ISU interest
- We alongside with the ex-executives have had a forum with Student Organisation co-ordinating body in SUC in matters pertaining to welfare of ISU members.
- The student newspaper (Hugin newspaper) in her September edition dedicated the centre page to the International Students and was published in English, which is perhaps the first of its kind. This is due to recognition of ISU.

Plans Ahead

Our usual slogan is that we want to give ISU members a home away from home. To this effect, we have outlined the following activities for the months ahead:

- *September*: Opening ceremony – old and new member gather together and also for all international student.
- *October*: Birthday party - for all the international student who has the birthday Sep and Oct. this activity shall be for each month onward.
- *November, December and January*: (We are arranging varieties of games, cultural events and Christmas party for international student who plan to stay in Stavanger
