- Renting cross-country ski to foreign students (in cooperation with the Office of Int. Relations)
- One International Buddy Quiz, that integrates Norwegian students with internationals
- International Film festival, in cooperation with ICOT
- Other activities based on the interest of foreign students and the available resources.
