In the Spring Semester 2009 the ISU board members elected in Autumn 2008 proposed a change of constitutions during the GA Spring 2009, that starting from Spring 2009 ISU Stavanger will only hold one general election and had reduce the number position on the ISU board from 11 to 6 board members. The changes were voted in and were passed through. Hence, in March 2009, the general election were held new board members voted in. Due to a small number of boards had made it difficult for the previous board to implement activities and programs for students specially when most the members were dimotivated. Moverover, ISU UiS went trough crisis were 4 of the board members left their positions, two quitted without giving any reasons, one quitted because of study reasons and one quitted for taking a new positions at Stor board. Based on this crisis I was asked by the former President, Mr. Mohamad T. Hussain and the former Sec. Student Affairs, Ms. Wieneke Ooman, and Sec. Communication, Mr. Atif Aslam to be the care take care later on throught some discussion, I was voted in as new President for our local branch for the Autumn Semester 2009. The first step I did when was lay the plan for recruting new members, by targetting the new students to fill up all the open positions. The plan was sucessful and right now we have full working board members.
